

A student absent from school for more than ten consecutive days because of health, physical impairment, or other circumstances approved by the Superintendent ~~will~~may be provided the services of a teacher or an aide in the home, ~~or~~ hospital, or other agreed upon location. Such services will be considered 'homebound instruction.' A second adult must always be present when a homebound instruction provider is working with the student.

Homebound instruction ~~Appropriate educational services~~ may begin as soon as eligibility has been established with a written statement from a licensed medical examiner and a written parental/guardian request. The Superintendent may waive this requirement for non-medical circumstances.

~~Such~~s Students receiving homebound instruction shall be included in calculating the average daily attendance.
