23564 2015-16 Compensatory EOC Program Review: Director of Federal & State Programs Julia Willett-Weekly presented this item for discussion. Ms. Willett-Weekly outlined the End of Course exam results of the District's high school students in tutoring and credit recovery. She reviewed results from the Fall 2015, Spring 2016, and Extended Year (summer) program.

Dr. Donna Smith asked if the number of times students had failed to pass the EOC exams after going through tutoring, credit recovery, or the extended year services programs would be provided. Mr. Crowe stated they would provide the requested information in a January update.

23565 2016-17 DCIT Index 1 Review: Director of Accountability and School Improvement Annette Macias along with subcommittee members presented this item for discussion.

Index 1 Student Performance covers all STARR tests taken by all students. The subcommittee presented the District's goals, action plans, and strategies for improving students' achievement. They highlighted instructional practices, staff development, and the teacher mentor program as components of this effort.

<u>Discussion of Request for Approval of Purchases over \$50,000</u>: Chief Financial Officer David Harwell presented this item for discussion. There were no contract/purchases that met this requirement.

<u>Discussion of Request for Approval of Budget Amendment #3</u>: Chief Financial Officer David Harwell presented this item for discussion. Mr. Harwell reported that the loss of local property tax valuations and state funding for lower enrollment were totaling nearly \$16.9 million in losses for the District; more than the \$14 million decline anticipated earlier this fall. This budget amendment includes budget cuts from various administrative departments.

<u>Energy Cooperative and Ector County ISD to Participate in TASB Energy Cooperative Purchasing Program</u>: Chief Financial Officer David Harwell presented this item for discussion. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate compliance with state procurement requirements to identify qualified vendors of electricity, transportation fuel and other types of energy products, commodities, and services (collectively "energy services") to relieve the burden of the governmental purchasing function, and to realize various potential economies including administrative cost savings, for Energy Cooperative members.

Five firms' submitted proposals and three are being recommended to form a pool to submit proposals for future needs. One of the first plans is to have an architectural firm provide a comprehensive assessment of all District campuses to gauge needs for the future. A formal quote for the cost will be forthcoming.
