Welcome back to a new year! I am so excited to get this year under way and it has been completely awesome to see all of our wonderful students again. I am pleased to announce that we will be renewing our emphasis on attendance in a positive way this year. We will be recognizing good attendance in a variety of ways, starting with trimester attendance reward activities. Students who have missed no more than 3 days in a trimester are eligible for the reward activity. Once again tardies and early leaves will count negatively against attendance for reward purposes. A Tardy = 1/2 day absence and an early leave = 1/2 day absence. Our first activity will be a school-wide movie on our big screen in the gym!

Evergreen is still a PBIS (positive behavior intervention support) and we are going to continue our monthly "GREEN ZONE" assemblies this year. Every student is eligible to attend our green zone assemblies each month automatically. A student can become ineligible by earning an office referral (for behavior), a bus citation or more than 2 redirection room passes. If a student becomes ineligible for one of the PBIS assemblies they may not attend that month. Their eligibility status will automatically reset following the current month's assembly for the next month.

One of the highest priorities for Evergreen staff is the safety of our students. For their safety we ask that afterschool plans <u>NOT BE CHANGED OVER THE PHONE</u>. We must receive a signed note that can be compared with our current enrollment form. We also ask that parents <u>SLOW DOWN</u> when driving on campus. I look out my window in the morning and I cannot believe how fast some cars are driving in the front parking lot of the school. This is a school and there are children present. Please slow down; how would you feel if you saw someone driving excessively fast near your own child?

Last but certainly not least I want to thank Kylee Hermann for their donation of our United States Flag! The flag they donated was their grandfathers and is very special to them and in turn is very special to Evergreen. It is a beautiful addition to the school and very much appreciated.
