BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

The College received 2 bids for the project. One from Burton Construction of Houston for \$1,834,504.00 and the other from Bass Construction of Rosenberg for \$1,827,000.00. The College agreed to give preference to the low bidder with the understanding that they would work with us to determine if there could be any "value engineering" that would be acceptable to the College and save some money on the project. Bass Construction agreed to the process and delivered a set of changes and modifications that could provide some savings to the College. After reviewing the changes recommended, the staff is recommending approval of the bid from Bass Construction at a modified cost of \$1,757,219.00.
