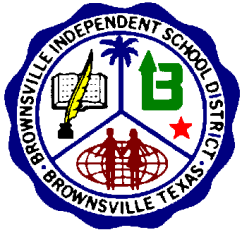

Registration for all students new to BISD who will be entering prekindergarten (3 years old) in **August 2021** will be held from **8:30 A.M. – 3:30 P.M.** starting Monday, January 25, 2021, at all BISD elementary schools, based on available space.

Important Information

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?
 To be eligible for enrollment, a child must be:

- Three (3) years old **on or before September 1, 2021.**
- All students must have the required documentation for enrollment.
- The BISD Code of Conduct will be followed.
- No transportation will be provided for the BISD Pre-K 3-Year-Old Program.

Each student satisfying the requirements will be admitted if his/her parent, guardian or person having lawful control of the student *resides within the district.*

REQUIRED INFORMATION:

- Student's birth certificate.
- Immunization records.
- Proof of residence (current utility bill, lease agreement or rental receipt).
- Proof of income (eligibility of lunch status).
- Parent/guardian photo identification.
- **Current proof of income on or after April 1 (eligibility of lunch status).**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Social Security Number is **NOT** required. If available, Social Security Numbers are requested to be used for identification purposes.
- All eligible students report to their school of choice to register.
- District will close any Pre-K 3-Year-Old Program at the campus that does not meet or exceeds enrollment capacity.

Prekindergarten students will be tested during the months of April-May to determine eligibility for the Bilingual/ESL Prekindergarten 3-Year-Old Program. Schools will provide you the time and date to test your child.

Preregistration for all students new to BISD who will be entering prekindergarten (4 years old) in August 2021 will be held from **8:30 A.M. – 3:30 P.M. starting Monday, January 25, 2021**, at all BISD elementary schools.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible for enrollment, a child must be:

- Four (4) years of age on or before September 1, 2021; and
- Educationally disadvantaged according to state standards; or
- Unable to speak and comprehend the English language; or
- Homeless; or
- The child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserved component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority; or
- The child of a member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserved component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty; or
- Foster care status; or
- The child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as: a peace officer; a firefighter; or an emergency medical first responder.

Each student satisfying the requirements will be admitted if his/her parent, guardian or person having lawful control of the student resides within the district.

REQUIRED INFORMATION

- Student's birth certificate
- A copy of the child's records from the school most recently attended
- Immunization records
- Proof of residence (current utility bill, lease agreement or rental receipt)
- Parent/guardian photo identification
- **Current proof of income on or after April 1st (eligibility of lunch status).**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Immunization records
- Proof of residence (current utility bill, lease agreement or rental receipt)
- Parent/guardian photo identification
- **Current proof of income on or after April 1 (eligibility of lunch status.)**

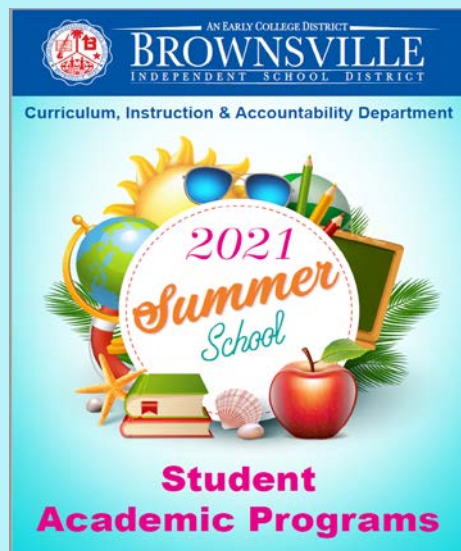
