Background Information: School districts and charter schools are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the commissioner that, for each subject in the required curriculum other than physical education, students have access to instructional materials that cover all the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). Districts and charters must submit certifications to receive access to ordering 20245–26 instructional materials through EMAT. Districts are required to list all materials used for Math, ELAR, Science, and Social Studies to cover 100% of the State standards. The materials listed in the attached document are used in Tier 1 instruction to cover 100% of standards in school year 2024-25.
<u>Fiscal Implication:</u> The State allocates Instructional Materials Allotment funds to purchase these materials. Our allocation for the 2023-2025 biennium is \$492,812. Approximately, \$140.000 is remaining. Additionally, one FTE is funded from this allotment. Without Board approval, the District is unable to access these funds
