Craig Elementary/ Middle School November & December 2024

- This year, CHS and CEMS are sharing 3 elective teachers. Music, PE and SEALS instructors are servicing all 3 schools each day. This translates to travel times for our 3 dedicated staff members. I would like to thank Racheal Balcom, Tricia Stock and Ronnie Fairbanks for making our daily schedules work in a fashion which provides culturally responsive classes for our students.

- CMS Basketball Season was a huge success! The CMS Boys BB team, coached by Brett Haws won this year's Middle School Stikine Basketball Tournament held in Petersburg and the CMS Girls Basketball team, coached by Vanessa James won the Prince of Wales Island Tournament. The gym was full for our home games and concessions did very well! Thanks Mrs. Sandra Marker for overseeing the concession stand. Thanks Athletic Director, Mr. Tobias Frieb for running our home games and organizing our CMS basketball season.
- As a district we are embarking on structured pre-scheduled Professional Learning Community (PLC) meetings almost every Friday this school year. Each PLC meeting will be focused on one of four types of meetings on a rotating basis. Building Level Needs, Student Focus, Teacher Time and Committee Meetings. There are 4 types of committees. School Safety Committee, Child Study Team Committee, Family Engagement Committee and Staff Wellness Committee. Teachers have selected which committee they prefer to work in. Each administrator will head up a committee of their choosing.
- "Battle of the Books" practice is held every Tuesday and Thursday for those 3rd through 6th Graders who are interested. Mrs. Tamara Cross volunteers her time to facilitate the practice and eventual competition.
- Thanks to Mrs. Tamara Cross, Mrs. Kellie Ebbighausen, Ms. Grace Beckman and Mrs. Christy House in regards to conducting the upcoming Family Literacy Night. It will be held on December 17th, 2024. Elementary parents are encouraged to attend with their students. Each student is given a brand-new book to take home. Refreshments are served.
- On November 8th, in recognition of Veteran's Day, CEMS students participated in the CTA Veteran's Day Luncheon. CES students created placemats, wrote "Thank You for Your Service Letters", center pieces for the tables and performed a "Readers Theatre" where 5th grade students read individual snippets detailing their appreciation of veterans. The CMS student council served as waiters and waitresses serving drinks, lunch platters and dessert. At the end of

the luncheon, the CMS Student Council members distributed Gift Bags to all attendees.

- On November 15, 2024 CES students were treated to a wonderful day of cultural awareness titled, "CES Youth Gathering & Cultural Day" by Haida, Tlingit and Tsimshaun community volunteers. The CCSD Indigenous Committee met on several occasions and came away with a day scheduled with Frybread Demonstrations, Holiday Ornament creations, Story Telling, iPad language App with Haida language, Weaving and Learning the Haida Friendship Song. A CES Youth Gathering & Cultural Day schedule is attached.
- Our CEMS 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, & 8th Grade students were administered the 2024 Fall NWEA MAP Growth test in early October.
- Three CES 4th Graders exhibited High Growth in Reading when compared to their 2023 Fall NWEA MAP Growth scores. Four CES 4th graders scored High Growth numbers in Math compared to their 2023 Fall NWEA MAP Growth scores. Also, three CES 4th graders scored High Achievement in Math when comparing their Fall 2023 MAP Growth scores. One CES 4th grade student scored High Achievement in Reading when compared to their Fall 2023 scores.
- Ten CES 5th grade students scored High Growth in Reading when compared to their 2023 Fall NWEA MAP Growth numbers. Five CES 5th grade students scored in the High Growth range when compared to their Fall 2023 NWEA MAP Growth numbers. Four CES 5th grade students scored High Achievement in Math and one in Reading. I have attached 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade profiles.
- CMS 2024 Fall MAP Growth scores indicated growth across the 6th, 7th and 8th classes, ranging from 4.6% to 4.9%. I have included 6th, 7th and 8th grade class profiles which provide a snapshot of where the students, as a class, scored on the October NWEA MAP Growth test. It's obvious we have our work cut out for us as educators. Our focus will be detailed in an upcoming staff meeting next Wednesday. We will target those areas requiring growth and examine our comparable 2025 Winter NWEA MAP Growth Scores with those of the 2024 Fall NWEA MAP Growth test.

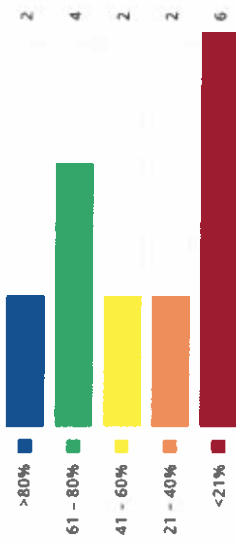

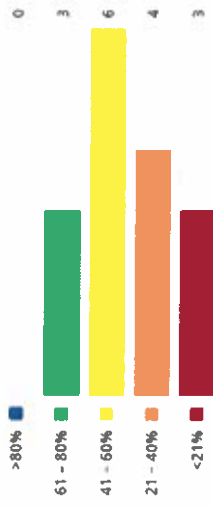

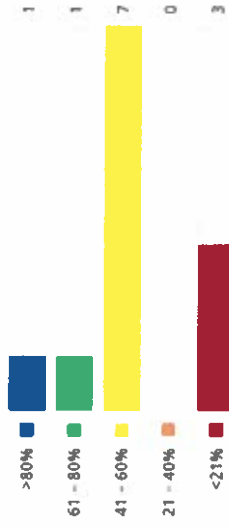

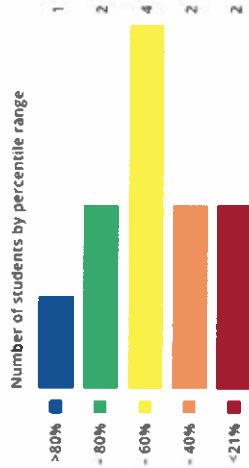

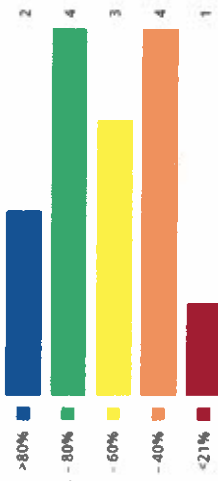

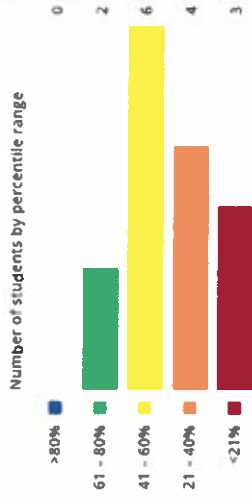

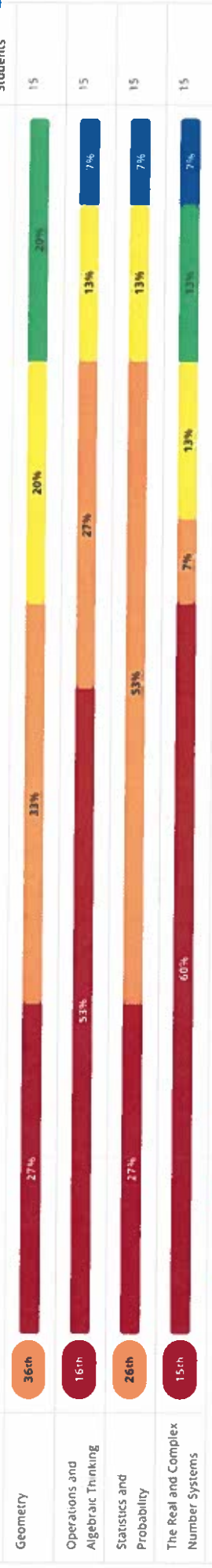
