- Fall MAP testing was completed at the end of August.
 - o Reading Increased 4 points from last fall 51st 55th
 - o Math Increased 4 points from last fall 50th to 54th
 - o Science Increased 9 points from last fall 53rd to 62nd
- The Panther Den hosted their annual 9/11 Remembrance ceremony for PJHS. The Panther Den students shared the events that took place on 9/11 and the choir performed *America the Beautiful* followed by Damon Gatons and Treyson Presnell playing Taps on their trumpets. The Panther Den has also started volunteering at the Methodist church this month. They help unload food for weekend backpacks from the delivery truck.
