HISTORY: Summit K12 is an online educational platform designed to help K-12 students—especially English Learners (ELs)—improve academic achievement through interactive, standards-aligned programs. It is commonly used in school districts across the United States, particularly in Texas, to support English Language Development (ELD), STAAR preparation, and TELPAS readiness.

RATIONALE: The rationale for using Summit K12 is to provide targeted, standards-aligned support for English Learners and struggling students, helping them build language proficiency and content mastery simultaneously. The platform offers, interactive lessons that address the specific demands of assessments like TELPAS and STAAR, enabling teachers to track both progress and achievement. By personalizing instruction and reinforcing academic vocabulary across subjects, Summit K12 offers individualized intervention for students. Given the results of this program last year, at the middle school, the plan is to use it district-wide.

BUDGET: The cost of this program is \$48,891 for the 2025-2026 school year. If approved, the cost will be covered with Title III, Part A funds which are received by the district to supplement the instruction for English Language Learners.
