LIMITED PUBLIC FORUM

At regular meetings or special meetings, the Board shall allot 15 minutes to hear persons who desire to make comments to the Board regarding any item posted for discussion, consideration, and/or possible action by the Board at that meeting. Persons who wish to participate in this portion of the meeting shall sign up with the presiding officer or designee before the meeting begins and shall indicate the agenda item or topic about which they wish to speak. Persons wishing to participate in this portion of the meeting shall be permitted to speak regarding items on the posted agenda. The Presiding Officer shall enforce this limitation. The Presiding Officer shall also determine the amount of time allotted to each speaker, based on the number of speakers who sign up before the meeting begins. Speakers shall be allotted an equal amount of time.

LIMIT ON PARTICIPATION

Other than the public forums identified above, public participation is limited to the time allotted for those individuals who have requested that an item be placed on the agenda. At all other times during the Board meetings, the audience shall not enter into discussion or debate on matters being considered by the Board, unless recognized by the presiding officer. No presentation shall exceed five minutes. Delegations of more than five persons shall appoint one person to present their views before the Board.

COMPLAINTS AND CONCERNS

Complaints and concerns raised by a person recognized by the presiding officer shall be referred to resolution channels as follows:
