The K-2 report cards have been slightly revised to better reflect the learning assessed. The Grades 3-5 report cards have been more significantly revised, moving to a standards-based reporting format. Like the K-2 versions, this change more accurately reflects the student learning as measured against the state's academic standards.

Representatives from the K-5 Report Card Task Force will be at the April board workshop to discuss the process used to develop the recommendations brought forward. Once board approved, the revised report cards will be implemented in the 2023-2024 school year.
