SHAC Activity Report



E-Cigarettes - Dolores Wise Barrera

Effective May 28, 2017, TEA made recommendations regarding instruction in public schools to prevent the use of e-cigarettes. As of October 2015 UISD implemented drug prevention and dangers of e-cigarettes in Health classes for middle and high school students and is referenced in UISD Policy FNCD Legal.

Police Officer Joe Casarez discussed students' use of drugs and/or marijuana using e-cigarettes in addition to use of inhalers, pen drives and perfume bottle look alikes for vaping.

Multiple Intelligence - Dr. Julissa Liendo

Described the different intellectual abilities and learning styles with regard to how students approach learning and mastering tasks.

Campus Safety - Chief Ray Garner

Informed on Department staffing which includes 97 Police Officers and the addition of more Securities Guards. Officers were trained on how to handle students as students and not as criminals

Suicide Risk and Awareness - Christina Uribe Flores

Discussed possible signs of suicide including withdrawal from activities, family, and/or friends, neglect of personal appearance, change in personal appearance, change in personality, risk-taking behavior, running away, alcohol and drug use.

Health Services – Mara Lopez

Shared the address of the four local locations and informed parents of all services that clinics provide, hours of service and insurance information.

Early Pathway/LCC Summer Academy — Mario Rosales

UISD in conjunction with LCC gave eligible Class 2021-2022 students an opportunity to attend receive up to 30 college credits by the time they graduate.

FitnessGram Report – Coach Jose Briones

Share how parents can instill Life Time Fitness in their children/students

Local Wellness Policy - Enrique Lira

Described a balance meal and recommended portions served to students daily. Discussed Nutrition Standards in the National School Lunch Program-Meal Pattern Chart in addition to the district's nutrition guidelines for all foods/beverages sold or marketed to students during the school day that are designed to promote student health and reduce childhood obesity.

Internet Safety and Mobile Apps - Jeanette Fernandez & Adriana Ramirez Munoz

Discussed the dangers of posting personal information on social media sites like Facebook, Snapchat, Instagram, WhatsApp, Yelp, Flickr, Vine, Tumblr and photo vaults hidden in calculator apps.
