Geneva Community Unit School District 304 Teacher Induction Program 2014/2015

1. Summer Orientation (half-day)

Information meeting for teachers new to District 304 held prior to the beginning of the school year (July and August). Topics include compensation procedures, employee benefits (e.g. health, dental, and life insurance, flexible spending plans, 403b tax-sheltered annuity program), personal and sick leave, Board of Education policies, an orientation to the District's technology resources, and completion of employment-related paperwork.

2. Staff Connections Website (can be accessed on the Geneva School District website under "staff" button)

A website with useful information about District programs, procedures, and people.

3. New Teacher Institute (three full days; one half-day)

Held the week prior to the beginning of the school year, two and a half days devoted to introducing new teachers to the history and tradition of the school district, administrative and support staff, school district curriculum, student health protocols, and building practices and procedures.

4. New Teacher Mentoring

A teacher new to District 304 is paired with an experienced teacher who offers practical and timely perspective and support during the school year.

5. Building Orientation

Orientation activities sponsored by individual buildings throughout the school year helping to foster socialization and the integration of new staff in the building.

6. Information Sessions (after school)

After school meetings offered throughout the school year focusing on issues of special interest to teachers new to District 304. A schedule of meeting dates and time will be distributed at the beginning of the school year.
