November marks the time of transition between fall and winter seasons both on the calendar and in our extracurricular activities as well. As of today, girls hockey has begun playing games with a home game last week against East Grand Forks, the first of three to be played at the WACC this season. Girls basketball and boys hockey began practice this week. Boys basketball and wrestling will start their preseason practices on November 18.
