SUBJECT: DISCUSSION OF AND REQUEST FOR APPROVAL TO SUBMIT A GRANT TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR ALERRT TRAINING FOR ECISD PEACE OFFICERS

DATE: November 14, 2023

On June,14 2023, Governor Abbott signed House Bill 3 into law. The legislation requires that school boards “must ensure that at least one armed security officer is present during regular school hours at each district campus.” Police officers must be trained with a minimum of Level One of the Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training (ALERRT) training. The purpose of the ALERRT Travel grant, FY 2024, is to provide assistance in paying overtime and travel expenses related to completing the ALERRT training. The opportunity to apply for this grant under the Governor’s office will enable ECISD to ensure all officers are in compliance with the ALERRT training requirements.

The ECISD Police Department requests approval to submit a grant application to the Office of the Governor of the State of Texas. The purpose of the grant is to provide financial assistance for ALERRT training and travel expenses for all ECISD Officers.
