RE: Minimum Grade Requirements in Advanced Courses for Participation in UIL Activities 2026-2027

Each school year, Gatesville ISD must maintain on file a list of advanced courses and post in the Gatesville High School Student Handbook a list of advanced placement, honors, or dual credit courses. If one of the courses below is not specifically offered at Gatesville High School, a student could attend the course through the Texas Virtual School Network (TXVSN). Students participating in UIL must maintain a minimum of a 60 average in all advanced courses to be considered passing with regard to the UIL “No Pass-No Play” rule.
