Program Expansion Opportunities

Seasonal Expansion:

- Spring Semester
 - Can follow the same model as the fall program
- Summer Program
 - Can be connected with summer school programming

High School Expansion Opportunities:

- General High School Program
 - Potential for a 1-hour daily format
- Pilot Program:
 - Opportunity to launch a pilot program specifically for the boys basketball team.



Next Steps for Program Implementation

School Collaboration & Promotion:

- Partner with the four middle schools to promote and advertise the program.
- Begin creating a student roster and a potential waitlist.
