**Subject:** Renewal of RFP #F1060-23 Student Athletic/UII Accident Insurance

### Background Information:

- The Board of Trustees previously renewed RFP #F1060-23 Student Athletic/UII Accident Insurance on June 9, 2025. If approved, this renewal would be the fourth year of a five-year term.
- If renewed, this University Interscholastic League (UIL) accident insurance policy would continue to provide coverage for students participating in UIL athletics and activities, including, but not limited to, cheerleading (including cheerleading summer camps), band, drill team, vocational classes, JROTC, FFA, and 4-H. The recommended policy would also continue to provide coverage for all participants in UIL-sponsored events. In addition, all PK–12 students participating in day field trips would continue to be covered under the policy.
- The proposed current insurance policy would continue to provide secondary coverage for medical expenses, rehabilitation, and durable equipment. If parents or guardians do not have primary medical coverage, this policy would then act as a primary policy.
- The awarded vendor(s) allows for the appointed Lewisville ISD administrative staff to meet and have direct contact with the insurance provider pertaining to claims, forms, and benefits if a claim is issued.
- Previous policy year claims analysis indicated the following:
  - 2023–2024: 152 claims were filed, with total policy claims paid of \$117,496.
  - 2024–2025: 101 claims were filed, with current year-to-date totals of \$76,942 for policy claims paid, incurred, and pending.
  - 2025–2026: 105 claims were filed, with current year-to-date totals of \$78,846 for policy claims paid, incurred, and pending.
- Best value involves considering several factors, which may include, but are not limited to, price, quality, availability, delivery timing, support, and other relevant factors. Awarding to multiple vendors does not obligate the District to make purchases.

### Administrative Consideration:

- The proposed policy offers the same coverage as Lewisville ISD's current policy, with no premium increase due to the District's historically low and consistent number of claims.
- Funds for these services will come from the Lewisville ISD Benefits Department budget.

- Previous annual expenditure:
  - 2025–2026: \$182,758
- Estimated annual expenditures: \$182,758 but will not exceed the approved budget.
- This procurement complies with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code.

**Recommendations:**

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the renewal of RFP #F1060-23 Student Athletic/UII Accident Insurance, the recommended vendor, and the estimated annual expenditures for one year.
