## **RESOLUTION APPROVING SURETY BOND OF TREASURER**

WHEREAS, before entering upon their duties, each School Treasurer must as required by Section 8-2 of the School Code (105 ILCS 5/8-2) execute a bond with a surety company authorized to do business in the State of Illinois, payable to the Board of Education of the school district for which he or she is Treasurer and conditioned on the faithful discharge of their duties (the "Bond"); and

WHEREAS, the penalty of the Bond shall be no less than 10% of the amount of all bonds, notes, mortgages, moneys and effects of which the Treasurer is to have custody (the "District financial assets"), as measured on the final day of the school district's most recent fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Bond shall be in the form specified in Section 8-2 of the School Code, which further provides that such Bond shall be approved by at least a majority of the members of the Board of Education, and shall thereafter be filed with the Regional Superintendent of Schools who shall file with the Illinois State Board of Education before September 1 in each year an affidavit showing which treasurers of school districts under his or her supervision and control are properly bonded; and

**WHEREAS,** a Bond satisfying the requirements of Section 8-2 of the School Code has been issued to the Board of Education of Streator Elementary School District No. 44, LaSalle County, Illinois by Liberty Mutual as surety five company in the penal sum of <u>Two million,</u> hundred thousand Dollars (\$ <u>2,500,000</u> ) naming , duly appointed School Treasurer of School District No. 44 Theresa Muntz as Principal for a term beginning <u>August 21</u> , 2024 and ending \_\_\_\_\_, a copy of which Bond is attached to and made a part August 21, 2025 of this Resolution;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Education of Streator Elementary School District No. 44, LaSalle County, Illinois (the "Board"), as follows:

**Section 1.** The above preamble recitals are affirmed to be true and correct and are incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution.

**Section 2.** The Board hereby approves the Bond, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution, and directs the School Treasurer to cause the original of the Bond to be timely filed with the Regional Superintendent of Schools for LaSalle County.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
