Senior Exit Conference 2018-19

Senior students meet with their counselor to complete the exit conference questionnaire. This survey is designed to provide information on our students plans upon graduation. It also provides some statistics in relation to their post-secondary planning. Students who plan to pursue a post-secondary education next year on a full or part-time basis is 87.1%. A total of 1526 college applications were submitted and resulted in a 56% acceptance rate.

Statistics from the Senior Exit Conference are based on self-reported information from students in a survey taken in April and May of 2019.

FAFSA statistics are provided from a partnership with the Illinois Student Assistance Commission.

2019 Senior Exit Conference

342 graduating seniors were surveyed by their counselors as to their plans following graduation:

- 38.6% Attend a four-year college or university
- 48.5% Attend a community college
- 2.6% Attend a trade school or apprenticeship
- 3.8 % Begin working and not attend school
- 3.5% Undecided
- 2.9% Join the Armed Services
- 1.1% Other
- A total of 342 surveyed graduates sent out 1526 applications for admission, 671 of these applications were denied.
- 71% of students of the class of 2019 are first-generation college students.
- 93% of students attending college are attending college in Illinois and 7% of students are attending out of state.
- While attending college, 69.5% of students will reside at home with family, 26.2% will live on campus, and 4.3% will live off campus not with family.
- 30% of students reported earning a scholarship. The senior class as a whole reported earning \$1,654,347 in scholarships to use at the schools they plan on attending.
- 74% of students filed the FAFSA as reported by ISAC.
- 59% of students who filed the FAFSA qualify for the Federal PELL Grant as reported by ISAC.
- 55% of students who filed the FAFSA qualify for the Illinois MAP Grant as reported by ISAC.
- 54% of students who filed the FAFSA had to complete Financial Aid Verification.

Of the 331 students who submitted applications:

37% submitted one

9% submitted two

8% submitted three

7% submitted four

11% submitted five

29% submitted six or more
