HCPH’s jurisdiction serves 2.5 million community members living in unincorporated areas of Harris County (outside the city of Houston) and 30 municipalities. HCPH is dedicated to promoting and protecting the health of community members by not just providing direct services but also serving as the county’s Public Health Strategist. This affirms our vision for Harris County, where all people can achieve their full potential for health and well-being regardless of their circumstances.
