Providence Elementary School Fire Alarm Renovation Purchase
November 16, 2021

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from Communication Concepts in the amount of \$164,047.47 for the fire alarm renovation purchase for Providence Elementary School.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This purchase will provide for the renovation of the existing fire alarm system at Providence Elementary School.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

This fire alarm renovation equipment and installation will be purchased through the Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative (BuyBoard). This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the 2018 Bond Authorization.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order and have the fire alarm renovation equipment installed as soon as feasible.
