- TASB Released Update 124 with revisions to Legal policies to align with changes in law and policy, as well as proposed Local policy revisions to align with updates to Legal policies and recently adopted policy updates.
- Keller ISD administration also proposed updates to Local Policy FFA.

| Code | Title | Change |
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| CAA | Fiscal Management Goals and Objectives: Financial Ethics | To better align with updated rules regarding federal grants found in the Code of Federal Regulations, deletes the phrase “or designee,” except in places where the designation of another individual could be in place of the superintendent or board president and not just the superintendent. |
| CDA | Other Revenues: Investments | Revisions made to specify that representatives with distributors of investment pools must be registered with the Texas State Securities Board, have membership in the Securities Investor Protection Corporation, and be in good standing with the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority. |
| CY | Intellectual Property | Clarifications made to circumstances under which the district’s intellectual property may be used and where ownership of intellectual property lies when material is created by a district employee. |
| DH | Employee Standards of Conduct | Provisions addressing tobacco and e-cigarettes revised to include nicotine products, regardless of whether the product contains tobacco. |
| EHB | Curriculum Design: Special Programs | Revisions reflected updated Administrative Code rules addressing dyslexia and related disorders, |

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| | | specifically inclusion of references to the Dyslexia Handbook and ARD committee decisions. |
| EHBB | Special Programs: Gifted and Talented Students | Updates to terminology throughout to align with changes to the Texas State Plan for the Education of Gifted/Talented Students, approved by the SBOE in September 2024. Additional revisions under Funding to align with requirements in the Education Code and Administrative Code rules. |
| FFG | Student Welfare: Child Abuse and Neglect | New subsection on Oral Reports recommended to comply with revisions to the Family Code and Administrative Code, and revisions under Making a Report clarify new requirements in Education Code. |
| GKA | Community Relations: Conduct on School Premises | New language added referencing electronic vaporizing devices. |
| CKE | Safety Program/Risk Management: Security Personnel | Revisions and additions to jurisdiction and duties of peace officers, school resource officers, and security personnel to better align with Texas Education Code and Texas Penal Code. |
| FFA | Student Welfare: Wellness and Health Services | Updates to clarify the roles of the district and School Health Advisory Committee. |
