EP&O Levy Results

The EP&O levy election has ended and was certified on Friday, February 20, 2026. The voters approved the Levy with a multi county passage rate of 58.22%. I want to extend my thanks to the voters for their continued support of the Mary M Knight School District.

Facilities:

Based on feedback from our Track Coaches and Athletic Director, we went out for quotes to install a temporary running surface on the empty field that has been used for track. We will be installing a 400 meter gravel surface in that area that can be used for Physical Education and for track. We also received a quote to mow and mulch the Scotch Broom in the tree line around the campus. This work has been awarded to Hansen Construction. We received a quote to install additional PE Lockers in both the Girls and Boys Locker rooms. Based on upcoming enrollment in grades 7-12 next year, we need additional PE/Athletic lockers next school year. This work will occur in Summer. We had our annual Septic System inspected as well as pumped out. Our system passed the inspection. Coaches and Maintenance are preparing the fields for spring sports. I met with a roofing contractor on Feb 13 and am waiting for a quote.

Athletics:

Winter Sports season ended on February 19th. Our Girls Basketball team had a great session and made it to the 3rd round of District Basketball. Also, we had Cloe Fetcher recognized this month for reaching the milestone of achieving 1,000 points during her HS basketball career. We had HS Wrestling make it to the 1st round of districts. Spring Sports begin March 2nd for HS and March 9th for Middle School.

Grants:

We were awarded a Career Preparation and Launch grant through OSPI to support our CTE program. The grant supports our Welding, Construction, and Photography CTE programs. The grant amount is \$124,000.

Food Service:

On March 17th, we brought in Chef Kent to work with our food service staff for professional development and training. The focus was baking and additional scratch made menu items that meet USDA/School Menu nutrition requirements.
