Work Session Topics

Discussion Items

- A. Administrator/Department/Committee Reports:
 - 1. **East Minico Update:** Bryan McKinney has shared a letter outlining the success of their Pirate Power Hour and the addition of a required eight grade applied math class.
- B. Superintendent's Report:
 - 1. **Moody's Rating Letter:** We have been informed that Moody's Investors Service reviewed and assigned a rating of A1 to our District.
 - 2. **Student Immunization Report:** The State Superintendent has shared the District ratings for completed immunizations and that of the State.

Policy Discussion:

- A. **D415/D515 Service Animals in Schools.** This is a new policy. It will be in both the student and staff section.
- B. **D501.50 Student and Family Privacy Rights.** This is also a new policy. It covers surveys given to students and personal information.

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- C. **D505.30 Soliciting and Accepting Grants or Donations.** This specifies the procedures to solicit donations or grants. It outlines that school-related groups, staff or administrators must have prior approval from the Superintendent.
- D. **Student Fees, Fines and Charges/Return of Property.** This is new from the ISBA discussing the collection of academic classes with fees.

Business:

- A. **Superintendent's Evaluation:** This has been completed for your review and submission to the State.
- B. **Permission to Use Minico Football Equipment for Summer Camps:** A letter from Dr. Perrigot requesting Board permission for use of football equipment is submitted along with a schedule of camps.
- C. **PMT WAN Proposal:** The proposal shows the cost to upgrade all schools to 1 G.
- D. **St. Nicholas Contracts:** There are two contracts; the first is for food services to provide meals to St. Nicholas students. The second contract is if in an emergency, they are allowed to evacuate to the District Service Center.
- E. New/Amended/Deleted Policies:
 - 1. **Policy D404.14 Sick Leave (1st Reading):** Changes were made regarding classified being able to use sick leave by the hour.
 - 2. **Policy D501.12 and 501.12A Attendance (1st Reading):** This has been revised to show that schools have the same procedures for attendance. The Secondary Schools Addendum has been reviewed and approved by those principals.
