### **School District Profile**

The Minidoka County Joint School District #331 is the 20th largest of Idaho's 118 school districts, covering 762 square miles in the Southeast region of Idaho and serving the populations of the cities of Paul, Rupert, Heyburn, Acequia, and Minidoka.

The District also has students attend from portions of Lincoln, Cassia, Jerome, and Blaine Counties. The District educates over 4,300 students in preschool through grade 12. The District currently has 8 schools: 4 elementary schools (grades K-5), 2 middle schools (grades 6-8), 2 high schools including one alternative Junior/Senior High School. The District also participates in a regional ARTEC and ARTEI Professional Technical Charter School.

The District offers a wide range of programs and services for its students. These include vocational and college preparatory classes. The District is one of the major employers in the county, employing over 600 people.

Rupert, Idaho is the county seat and the largest city of Minidoka County, Idaho. It is filled with rich history and beautiful scenic views.
