

# Six Flags Trip Information

**October 4-5, 2014**

This will be the 18th trip that I have taken the band on to Six Flags, which is located in Vallejo, California. This trip was started by a former band teacher as a reward for successful participation in band.

All times are estimates. Students are encouraged to visit the Six Flags web site for detailed information about the park. This itinerary has some changes from the one that was sent last May, including a reduction in the cost of the trip.

We are planning to take the trip on October 4-5, 2014. Transportation will be provided by First Student.

## **Saturday Oct. 4:**

5:00 A.M. Depart Fleming for Six Flags. Please do not arrive before 4:30 A.M.

We will make a few rest stops on the way down. This will **probably** include a gas stop which will give the students the opportunity to buy snacks if they wish. Make sure to pack food for the ride down in case we do not stop.

12:30 Arrive at Six Flags and spend the day at the park.

10:00 P.M. Load bus and depart for Dinner.

10:15-11:15 Dinner at In and Out Burger

We will make a few rest stops on the way back.

## **Sunday Oct. 5:**

7:00 A.M. Arrive at Fleming. We will begin calling parents when we get to Rogue River. Be prepared to pick your student up from Fleming early.

## **Rules:**

1. All school rules.\*
2. Stay in groups of three or more.
3. Do not leave the park.
4. All media must be G or PG rated

\*Food, gum, electronic devices and hats are allowed.

**Cost:**

The cost of the trip will be \$71.00. This covers the bus as well as admission. Students will need to bring additional money for food and purchases. The cost of the trip will be due on in the office by Monday, September 15.

All times are approximate. Mr. Wilder has no control over things like flat tires, traffic, power outages, or weather. Just as with all out of state field trips, this trip will depend on school board approval.

The Fleming staff members that are going are Mrs. Galusha, Mr. Stuckey and Mr. Wilder. We have three parents going as well.
