

The regular meeting of the Board of Education, Independent School District #595, East Grand Forks, Minnesota was held on Tuesday May 26, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. in Room 195 at Senior High.

Board Chair Brott called the regular meeting to order, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Brott moved to approve the agenda as presented. King seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

Superintendent Grover reported that the school year concluded successfully and thanked those who participated in graduation at the new venue, noting positive feedback from the many attendees. He provided updates on Nexus, Long-Term Facility Maintenance (LTFM) planning, ongoing data requests, and administrator evaluations. He also reported that the Grand Forks School Board approved the Career Impact Academy Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). Brott moved to approve the hire of Wyatt Hangsleben a summer maintenance worker. Holweger seconded the motion. Board Member Hansgleben recused himself from the vote. Motion carried 3-0.
