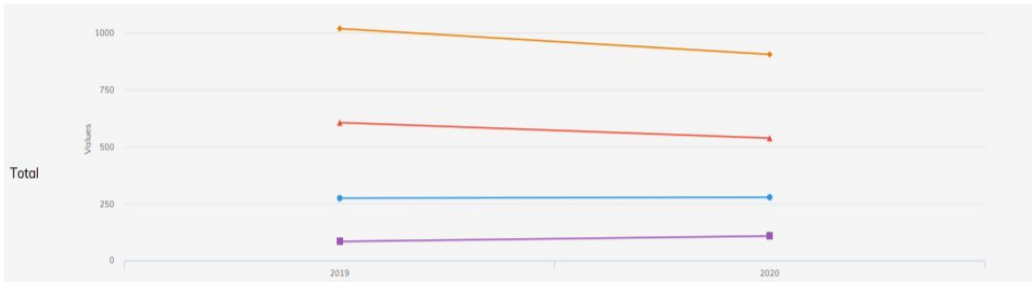

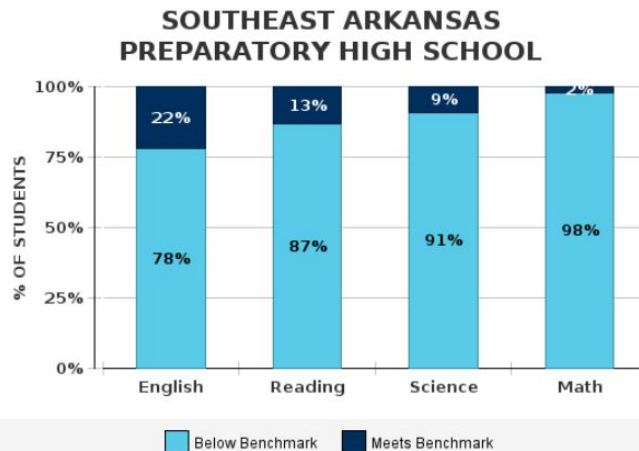

Financial Solutions



- December 2019: Switched to APSRC Finance Department for financial bookkeeping services.
- Coding issues are being corrected.
- Growth Funding Payments will be received in January (1st Qtr ADM: 106.11), and are expected in March (2nd Qtr. ADM), and May (3rd Qtr. ADM)
- Child Nutrition reporting deficiencies are being corrected and child nutrition claims are being submitted.
 - August & September reimbursements have been issued.
 - October & November reimbursements are scheduled to be issued.
 - Training is being provided to SEA Prep's Administrative Assistant to submit accurate, timely reports.
- **Projected ending balance for 2019-20: \$100,853**
