*SUPPORTING DATA (summarization, attachments, description, & etc.): Eric Banuelos, Agriscience instructor and four of his advanced students would like to attend the McPeak's Be A Champ Show Cattle Camp, being held in Warner, Oklahoma, June 29 to July 2, 2014. Cattle Showmanship is not an easy skill to learn. A good showperson is a person that has a sense or knack for an effective presentation of an animal. In showmanship, students are judged on their abilities to control and present their steer or heifer to bring out its best characteristics. By attending the Be A Champ camp students will be provided with hands on course where they will learn techniques and tips on clipping, hoof trimming, show day dressing, showmanship, feeding and general animal care. They will also learn many of the solutions to problems that Jerry McPeak has encountered in over 32 years of showmanship training. At all times our students are under direct supervision. Our students would leave on Saturday, June 28 th and would return on Thursday, July 3 rd .

*SUMMARY OR RECOMMENDATION: Advanced planning and hard work is the key to becoming a good showperson.
