STUDENT ACTIVITIES

	Student organizations may participate in events with the permission of the Superintendent and to the extent that such participation does not conflict with the objectives for which the schools are estab- lished and the welfare of the students is dedicated.
	Events that are for the purpose of private gain, for the promotion of any commercial project or product, for the furtherance of any politi- cal partisan interest, or any sectarian concern shall not be ap- proved for school group participation. The Superintendent may make exception when it is mutually beneficial to the student or the school.
EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY ABSENCES	The District shall make no distinction between absences for UIL activities and absences for other extracurricular activities approved by the Board. A student shall be allowed in a school year ten extracurricular absences not related to post-district competition, five absences for post-district competition prior to state, and two absences for state competition. The District shall allow an additional ten days for extracurricular absences.
LIVESTOCK SHOWS	The Wilson County Livestock Show shall be treated as an extracur- ricular activity whereby students may be allowed make-up work should participation be required on the day of the show, and pro- vided the student is passing all subjects.
	The school shall make every effort to schedule a holiday on the Friday of this show.
	All major livestock shows shall be considered extracurricular.
	Students must comply with extracurricular rules to participate.
USE OF DISTRICT FACILITIES	School-sponsored student groups may use District facilities with prior approval of the appropriate administrator. Other student groups may use District facilities in accordance with policy FNAB.
