Swim and Diving team placed 4th out of 9 teams in district.

We have many students volunteering to help with the Beltway "Night to shine" special needs prom on Feb. 8.

Our National Honor Society, Friends of Rachel, and Student Council members assisted with the cleaning of classrooms, and restrooms during a custodial shortage.

Wylie Speech team competed in the Heat of Texas UIL Invitational. Mattie Smith placed 2nd and Wes Horn placed 3rd in Prose Interpretation. Melia Messer placed 3rd and Anna Clair Boon placed 2nd and Kobe George placed 1st in Poetry Interpretation. Emy Pablico placed 1st in Persuasive Extemporaneous Speaking.

Results of the Ft. Worth Ag Mechanics Show- The trailer team won their class. They also competed in the M.A.D.E. competition (Mechanics, Agriculture, Development and Education program). Dalon Moore received 4th in the competition and received an \$8,000 scholarship.
