Agenda Item Caption: Discussion of Texas Academic Performance Report, Progress Report on Early Childhood Reading & Math and Career, College and Military Readiness (CCMR) Goals, Information from Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, PEIMS Financial Standard Reports, and Report on Violent or Criminal Incidents, and Public Hearing

Purpose of Agenda Item: Information, for discussion and public hearing.

Administrative Recommendation: Following the presentation of the reports, the Board President will open the floor to the public hearing for comments on the reports. After closing the public hearing, no further action is needed.

Background Information: The Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR) provides information on the performance of students in each school and district in Texas every year. Performance indicators are disaggregated by ethnicity, sex, special education, economic status, and limited English proficiency status. The report also provides extensive information on school and district staff, finances, programs, and demographics. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board report provides student performance information on students who graduate from our district and enter a Texas public college or university. School districts are required to report findings from these documents as well as a locally developed report of Violent or Criminal Incidents. The annual report presentation includes the progress towards meeting House Bill 3 (86th Legislature) goals in early childhood literacy and math and, college, career, and military readiness. KISD disseminates the reports through the district's website. A notice of the public hearing was placed in the *Killeen Daily Herald* and posted on the district's website.

Regulatory Requirement: *Texas Education Code*, Section 39.053 requires each district's Board of Trustees to publish an annual report, conduct a public hearing on the annual report, and widely disseminate the report. For public viewing, the following District reports can be found on the KISD website home page: TAPR, Texas Higher Education Report, Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) Financial Standard Report and Violent or Criminal Incidents Report. Campus objectives can be found in each individual Campus Improvement Plan, which are located on their individual campus web pages on the KISD website.
