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Claims

- Out total reimbursement for May of 2016 is 178,081.18 compared to last year's claim of 160,002.95 for a difference of \$18,078.23. We had the same number of serving days this year that we had last year 19.
- The numbers of breakfasts served this year were 43,175 compared to 37,137 last year. We served 6,091 more breakfasts this year of which 4,153 were at Heyburn Elementary with their classroom breakfast program.
- The lunch numbers this year were 46,445 and last year was 44,574 for a difference of 1,871. We averaged 2,444 per day in 2016 and 2,346 per day in 2015 for the month of May.

Projects

- We have awarded the bid for a new cooler box for East Minico to BS&R Equipment out of Twin Falls for \$17,865.61. This price includes tear down of old box and set up of new box. They will also hook up the refrigeration.
- We will award the bid for new ovens at Minico, Rupert Elementary, East Minico and West Minico as soon as the state approves the bids.
- We have started our summer programs and everything has been going well. We would encourage any of you to come by any of the four parks and see how we do the lunch in the park program.
