**Recommendation:**

**Issue Summary:**

The North Slope Borough School District replaced a total of 1,529 outdated Macbooks under the computer refresh process with the highest bid made by Diamond Assets. The Macbooks are outdated by one to three years and are valued at \$194,549.00 in the current condition. The devices graded total came to the amount of \$212,224.00 with \$17,675.00 in deductions due to conditions varying by etchings and missing/bad MagSafe chargers.

The Macbooks have been replaced and have a replacement cycle of five years.
