- 1. Provide a DETAILED RATIONALE explaining how the waiver will enhance student learning opportunities, promote innovation, or increase equitable access to effective teachers. Include information about the problem or obstacle, if any, the waiver will help the district overcome.
 - KIPP Delta currently has four of the five schools in the district having a letter grade of D or F. This problem has a myriad of root causes, but one is the need to ensure Tier I instruction is delivered prior to state assessments. Analysis of previous calendars reveals that the third and fourth quarter are longer than the first and second quarter, thereby putting more instructional time on the end of the year and not the beginning. By starting the school year earlier, we aim to address this challenge head-on by providing additional instructional days before standardized assessments, which will allow us to better prepare our students for academic success. This extended instructional time will facilitate more targeted interventions for struggling students, as well as opportunities for advanced coursework and enrichment activities for high-achieving students.
 - KIPP has a robust summer learning enrichment program. The effectiveness of the summer learning
 is impacted by school ending in June based on the current mandates. Starting the school year early
 will allow a full 4-6 week summer program and will also allow teachers to have much needed
 summer time for PD and personal rejuvenation.
 - o Summer enrichment
 - Early literacy grades K-2
 - Intermediate STEM Camp 3-5
 - Rising 6th grade camp (Helena) / Rising 7th grade camp (Blytheville) / Rising 9th grade camp (Helena)
 - ACT Boot Camp (10-12)
 - Starting the school year five days earlier (August 12) will allow each quarter to be 45-48 days, allowing a more equalized Fall (91 days) and Spring (93 days) semester, allow for the five inclement weather days, and for 4 regional PD days to be embedded into the master calendar.
 - An early start to the school year will enable us to promote innovation in teaching and learning. With
 the additional time afforded by an early start, our educators will have the opportunity to engage in
 professional development initiatives focused on innovative instructional strategies, technology
 integration, and differentiated instruction. This investment in teacher professional development will
 ultimately result in improved student outcomes and increased engagement in the learning process.
 - an early start to the school year will help us address the challenge of equitable access to effective teachers. With a longer instructional calendar, we will have the flexibility to stagger professional development days throughout the year, ensuring that all teachers have access to high-quality professional learning opportunities without disrupting instructional time. This approach will help to attract and retain effective teachers, particularly in hard-to-staff subject areas and high-needs schools, ultimately promoting greater equity in educational opportunities for all students.

Instructional delivery will not be adversely affected by this waiver. This waiver will support students because it allows teacher PD days to be embedded in the school year to support effective TIER I instruction and instructional delivery based on researched practices.

This plan will involve regular assessments of student learning outcomes via NWEA MAP, iReady, and ATLAS, surveys of teachers and parents, classroom observations, and analysis of attendance and dropout rates. We will also solicit feedback from stakeholders and use this information to make informed adjustments to our instructional practices and policies.
