# **Summative Designation 2024**

### **Growth versus Proficiency**

Growth	Proficiency
Measures a student's change in knowledge or skills over time. Growth is not penalized for a student's starting point, and it recognizes that students of all backgrounds can grow.	Measures whether a student has mastered a common standard.

Illinois assessments use both growth and proficiency to calculate summative designations, which describe how well a school is meeting its students' needs.






