- Academic Focus: Instruction is already underway with an emphasis on the new curriculum (Benchmark) and guided math implementation.

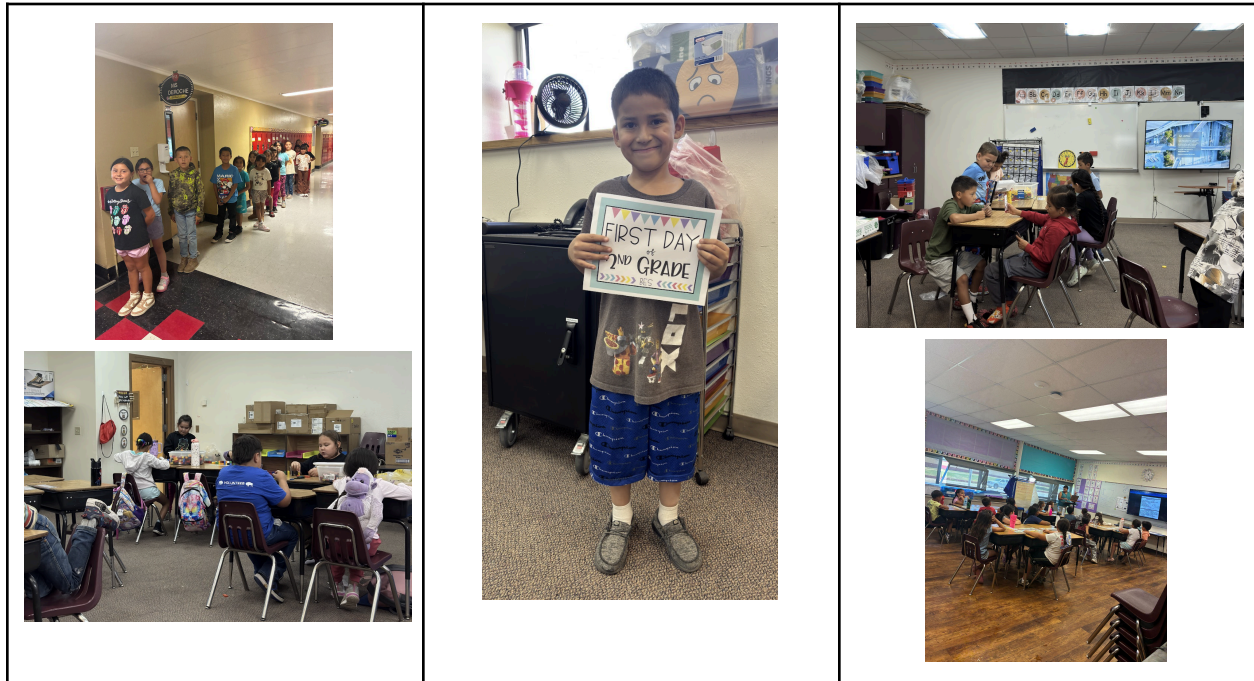
- Family Engagement: BES Open House was held with numerous students and families in attendance.
