Section 6: Application For Expedited and General State Waiver

- 1. Celina Independent School District is requesting one extra student holiday to host an elementary and middle school UIL Academic contest.
- 2. No, the district was assigned this duty by the UIL district executive committee after the district and campus improvement plans were approved.
- 3. Section 25.081(a) of the Education Code states, "Except as authorized under Subsection (b) of this section, Section 25.084, or Section 29.0821, for each school year each school district must operate so that the district provides for at least 180 days of instruction for students." The district is asking to reduce the number of days of instruction so teachers and staff can assist in hosting a UIL Academic contest.
- 4. The plan to be implemented requires contest administrators, monitors, graders, and student supervisors. The number of people needed to host the contest and the space needed to accommodate this large number of participants is greater than we can accommodate with the district student body present. The district is preparing this contest so that all school districts involved will only miss one day of instruction, rather than the better part of two days in a two-day contest.
- 5. By asking and receiving this waiver from the State of Texas, the district wants to promote academic achievement for the students of Celina ISD. This day will allow our district to provide an educationally rich environment that will leave a lasting impact on all students, staff, and community members who are involved.
- 6. Evaluation of the waiver will come through the number of students who participated in a academic contest and benefited from its effects. Celina ISD is dedicated to embracing excellence through all district and campus goals that place an emphasis on academics. This waiver would allow us to continue that tradition of promoting higher learning through a contest setting.
