During Fiscal Year 2023, with the help of the Bemidji Lumberjack Foundation, the District was able to purchase a video scoreboard that resides in the main gym at Bemidji High School. This video scoreboard has the capabilities to broadcast advertisements during activity events. There have been multiple organizations that have approached the activities department about advertising on the video board as a way to help support the activities program. Below is the proposed advertising plan for the Bemidji High School video board:

Bemidji High School Activities Department is authorized to provide advertisements on the BHS video board during indoor varsity regular season athletic events for Volleyball, Boys and Girls Basketball, Boys and Girls Wrestling and Dance. These advertising spots will consist of rotating logo exposures during pregame, in-game and post-game and/or additional spotlight options for specific actions, for example "ace", "dunk", etc.

All advertisements will be reviewed and approved by the High School Coordinator of Activities for compliance with school board policy.

Each entity will have the option to sign a one-year or two-year commitment for an advertisement spot that would run from July 1st through June 30th. In addition, with their advertisement they will receive one event pass which includes admission to all regular season varsity home athletic events.

All revenue generated from these advertisements will be used for the Bemidji High School activity programs as additional funds to support operations for all our activities offered, this includes athletics, fine arts, and clubs. A committee will be in place to review and approve requests as needed. Committee members will consist of the High School Coordinator of Activities, Activities Administrative Assistant, Director of Business Services, one coach from athletics, one advisor for fine arts, and one advisor for clubs. Revenues and expenses will be tracked separately in the accounting software and unspent revenue will be tracked in an assigned fund balance.
