BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Performance-Based Monitoring Analysis System (PBMAS) is used as one part of the overall annual evaluation of school districts' performance and program effectiveness. The PBMAS is a district-level, data-driven analysis system developed and implemented annually since 2004 by Performance-Based Monitoring (PBM) staff in coordination with other agency divisions and departments.

The PBMAS report looks at data in four areas:

1. English as a Second Language (ESL)
2. Career and Technology (CTE)
3. No Child Left Behind (NCLB)
4. Special Education (SPED)
