**ITEM: XII.**

**TOPIC: Boiler Replacements**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase and installation of new boilers at Franklin High School, Riley Upper Elementary School, Roosevelt Elementary School, and Coolidge Elementary School from SysTemp Corporation, Rochester Hills, Michigan for a cost of \$1,510,000.00 and at Emerson Middle School from Detroit Boiler Company, Detroit, Michigan for a cost of \$245,461.85, plus 8% contingency on the total project in the amount of \$140,438.15 for a total approved amount of \$1,895,900.00.

**RATIONALE:**

We are in the process of implementing the District's 10-year facility sinking fund plan, which includes boiler replacement at schools throughout the District. The current boilers at the aforementioned schools are nearing the end of their useful life and are in need of replacement. This will be a Sinking Fund project with a timeline for completing all buildings in the fall of 2020, prior to the heating season.
