SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF LOCAL AT-RISK CRITERIA

BOARD GOAL: All students will achieve educational excellence.

FISCAL NOTE: None

Background Information:

- Annual compensatory education allotment for each student educationally disadvantaged or who does not have a disability and resides in a residential placement facility in the district in which the student's parent or legal guardian does not reside
- Number of educationally disadvantaged students determined by Education Code 42.152 (b)
- Education Code 29.918; 19 TAC 89.1071- At-risk students include students under the age of 21 years at risk of dropping out of school who meet one of thirteen criteria (attached)
- Student who satisfies local eligibility criteria adopted by a Board may receive compensatory education services
- District may use compensatory education allotment to fund supplemental programs and services designed to eliminate any disparity in performance on state assessment instruments or disparity in the rates of high school completion between students at risk of dropping out of school.

Administrative Considerations:

- The administration request board approval to adopt the following local criteria for identification of students at risk of dropping out of school.

Students selected by campus committee who are in need of effective alternative academic instruction and support.

- Principal Break-Out Meeting- May
- Assistant Principal Meeting- May
- Technology and C & I Weekly Meeting
- Part of Internal PEIMS data system

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The administration recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the adoption of the local at-risk criteria as presented.
