GRADING/PROGRESS REPORTS TO PARENTS MAKEUP WORK

EIAB (LOCAL)

DELETE POLICY

Students shall be expected to make up assignments and tests after absences. Students shall receive a zero for any assignment or test

not made up within the allotted time.

Students shall be permitted to take tests administered in any class

missed because of absence.

For any class missed, the teacher may assign the student make-up work based on the instructional objectives for the subject or course and the needs of the individual student in mastering the essential knowledge and skills or in meeting subject or course requirements.

A student shall be responsible for obtaining and completing the make-up work in a satisfactory manner and within the time speci-

fied by the teacher.

Teachers may assign a late penalty to any project turned in after LATE PROJECTS

the due date in accordance with previously established guidelines

approved by the principal and disseminated to students.

Students who have lost credit due to excessive absences and UNEXCUSED whose absences are unexcused and not supported by extenuating **ABSENCES**

circumstances may be awarded credit by completing all make-up work with a grade no higher than 80 and by completing additional assignments through participation in one or more of the conditions

listed at FEC(LOCAL).

The District shall not impose a grade penalty for make-up work af-SUSPENSION

ter an absence because of suspension.
