## **Instruction**

## **Community Resource Persons and Volunteers**

The Board of Education encourages the use of resource persons (guest lecturers) and volunteers to: (1) increase students' educational attainment, (2) provide enrichment experiences for students, (3) increase the effective utilization of staff time and skills, (4) give more individual attention to students, and (5) promote greater community involvement.

The Superintendent shall establish procedures for securing and screening resource persons and volunteers. A person who is a "sex offender," as defined by the Sex Offender Registration Act, or a "violent offender against youth," as defined in the Child Murderer and Violent Offender Against Youth Registration Act, is prohibited from being a resource person or volunteer. <u>All volunteer coaches must comply with the requirement to report hazing in policy 5:90, Abused and Neglected Child Reporting.</u>
