- All, spring sports district tourneys are starting this week and will continue through next week. Our teams have had a great spring thus far.
- **Baseball:** Currently our varsity baseball teams league record is 6-2. Their district tourney starts on today in Weiser. Our varsity team enters the tourney as the number two seed. If they advance to the state tourney it will be at TVCC on May 17, 18, and 19th. The JV team had a great year as well. There weren't enough JV teams in our conference to have a district tourney.
- **Softball:** Our softball team has a league record of 8-0. They will be heading into the district tourney as the number one seed. Their district tourney will be held in Payette.. If the varsity team advances to state, their state tourney will be in Idaho Falls on May 18 & 19th. The JV team had a great season finishing undefeated in league play and winning their district tourney.
