



APPOINTMENT OF REAL ESTATE AGENT

POLICY ISSUE / SITUATION:

To support the purchase of land for a new elementary school as outlined in the 2014 Bond program, the School Board of Beaverton School District shall appoint a Real Estate Agent for the 2015-16 fiscal year.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In May 2014, voters approved a \$680 million bond that includes the purchase of land for a new school. The District will need the services of a Real Estate Agent. Similar to appointment of legal counsel, appointment of a real estate agent of record qualifies as an exemption to a competitive procurement process, because the nature of the contract work requires an ongoing, long-term relationship of knowledge and trust.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the School Board approve the following resolution.

(15-560) BE IT RESOLVED that Ed Hayden of Hayden Group LLC, be and hereby are appointed to serve as Real Estate Agent of Beaverton School District for the fiscal year 2015-16.
