COVID PROTOCOL

Should my child wear a mask?

▶ ATTENTION:

SSAISD is requiring all staff and students to adhere to mask usage in school buildings.

What if someone exhibits symptoms while at school?


- ▶ The nurses will immediately notify parents for medical follow up. The individual will be sent home. The student will need medical documentation with clearance for school and must be 24H fever-free

Students/Staff /Faculty sent home with COVID-19 Symptoms:

- ▶ 5 days' isolation & on day 6 may return to school and MUST wear a mask around other PLUS
- ▶ Symptom resolving PLUS
- ▶ 24 hours' fever free
- OR
- ▶ Note/Evaluation from doctor giving alternative diagnosis clearing for return school
- OR
- ▶ Obtain an acute infection test at an approved testing location that comes back NEGATIVE for COVID-19

Students/Staff/Faculty who test Positive for COVID (vaccinated and unvaccinated):

- ▶ 5 days' isolation & on day 6 may return to school and MUST wear a mask around others PLUS
- ▶ Symptom resolving Plus
- ▶ 24 hours' fever free
- ▶ All individuals who test positive can continue testing positive for up to 90 days (if this applies, those will be exempt from any further isolation within that time frame)



(All students in Athletics will be able to participate in the program after a 5-day stay home period and on day 6 MUST wear a mask around others.)

(Students/Staff/Faculty who have a Positive PCR no longer can present 2 negatives test to return to school per Metro Health)

Students/Staff/Faculty sent home for exposure to COVID-19:

- ▶ **NONE (PER TEA no contact tracing will be completed)**
- ▶ Nursing staff will guide families individually who are requesting contact tracing in the home setting.
- ▶ If applicable all students who are to stay home, will be referred to remote learning.
