- We are still on the search for some fall coaches.

American Indian Education Program Director

- Submitted 2025-2026 AIEA grant and plan to MDE on June 1 with plans to co-host seasonal traditional events with AIPAC and PIIC.
- We received an additional nearly \$80,000 for Native Language Revitalization grant for resources for classrooms at each school level.

Buildings & Grounds

- Kevin Neuman, the new Director of Buildings & Grounds first day with Red Wing is Monday, June 23, 2025.

Communication

- We had a nuclear response tabletop review June 5. We are updating the Safety manuals accordingly.
- The class of 2025 webpage will shift to class of 2026 in mid-summer. We had a surge in users throughout May, naturally, with a high mark of 809 on May 28.
- Messaging continues on the mascot exemption process.

Community Education

- Adult Behind the Wheel is now being offered through the Driver's Ed program.
- Kids Junction is currently taking a waiting list for many age groups for summer.
- Several of our summer programs and camps are full with waiting lists.

Human Resources

- Recruitment for the 2025/26 school year is in full swing. We're actively sourcing candidates for several essential roles, including Special Education Teachers (K-12 and Early Childhood), Paraprofessionals, High School Math Teacher, District-Wide ESL Teacher, Grade 6 ELA Teacher, and Community Education Office Manager.
- Our first Kavira Health Biometric Clinic on May 30th at the High School and Burnside Elementary was a resounding success, with 76 employees and retirees participating. All available appointment

slots were filled for this valuable, free wellness opportunity. We plan to schedule another clinic for late 2025.

- Lots of valuable leadership events and trainings occurred in June including RWPS Principal Admin Retreat (June 9-10), Big 9 Leadership Conference (June 12), and MN Legislative Updates + Paid Family Medical Leave (June 17).

Nursing Services

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Special Services

- We have completed the second week of Extended School Year Services. Programs are running from 9-3.
- We are continuing to interview and hire for special education teaching and paraprofessional positions for the 2025-2026 school year.

Student Nutrition Services

- We're currently planning to purchase new organizational items to help us maintain the high volume of meals we've been producing as a ship-out site. These additions will support a more efficient kitchen operation.
- Our department is currently sufficiently staffed, based on the results of the MPL tool as recommended by the USDA.
- The Summer Feeding Program is currently undergoing a review by MDE. We are in the process of preparing the necessary materials ahead of their onsite visit, scheduled for mid-August.
- We are using a variety of approaches to help families understand the importance of completing the application for educational benefits. Our team is developing new tools and advertising strategies to encourage as many families as possible to participate.

Teaching & Learning

- The awesome media team has been busy getting new curriculum and instruction materials ready and organized for next school year.
- K-5 teachers received training on the new math curriculums on June 2 & 3.
- District staff attended the Big 9 Leadership conference on June 12.
