Lisle Junior High School

Summer School

Lisle Junior High School will offer a three-week in-person session in June, provided by invitation to students with the greatest need of targeted work within specific deficit learning areas. Nineteen (19) students participated in the programs last summer and received support toward meeting essential learning standards in Mathematics and English Language Arts.

In addition to the in-person summer school opportunity, the self-paced online iReady reading and mathematics modules will be available to all students this summer.

Lisle High School

Summer School

Lisle High School will offer three summer school options this year: Credit Recovery, advancement courses, and Driver Education. For reference, last summer:

- Twenty-one (21) students were eligible for credit recovery semester classes. Sixteen (16) of those students attended and recovered a total of 18 classes.
- Forty-two (42) students opted to participate in advancement courses to earn credits through three approved providers (Edgenuity, Brigham Young University Independent Study, Northwestern University)
- Eleven (11) students completed an accelerated Driver Education course
